Your Route to Higher Rights of Audience

BPP are accredited by the Solicitors Regulation Authority to provide the training and assessment necessary to become a solicitor advocate.

If you are a PSC student, your route to Higher Rights of Audience is via the Development Route.

This route involves completing the following two stages:

- **STAGE 1 - PROCEDURE, ETHICS & EVIDENCE**

This is the academic stage of the training. It includes 3 days of training and a 2 hour 15 minute written examination. You can specialise in either civil or criminal proceedings, but some time will be spent on your non-specialist subject.

- **STAGE 2 - ADVOCACY**

This includes 3 days of training and a written and an oral assessment. You can specialise in either civil or criminal proceedings, but some time will be spent on your non-specialist subject.

By undertaking Stage 1 of the Development Route, you will satisfy your entire elective requirement. You can undertake Stage 2 of the Development Route as part of your PSC, or at a later date once you have qualified.
