If you're looking to become a New York lawyer, we are here to help you prepare for the New York Bar Exam, so you can achieve your ambitions and continue your success.

In difficult times you need to stand out from the crowd - the New York Bar will make you more marketable and enhance your employment opportunities in the US and the UK.

How it works

In order to qualify as an attorney-at-law in the State of New York, you must pass the New York State Bar Exam. The exam is held in New York twice a year in February and July. The bar examination is over two days:

- **Day 1** - The New York section, consisting of five essay questions, 50 multiple choice questions and one Multistate Performance Test question.
- **Day 2** - The Multistate Bar Examination (MBE), consisting of 200 multiple choice questions

In addition to the New York State Bar Exam, all candidates must also pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE), which examines ethics and professional conduct. The MPRE may be taken at any time, but must be passed before a candidate can be admitted to practice in New York.

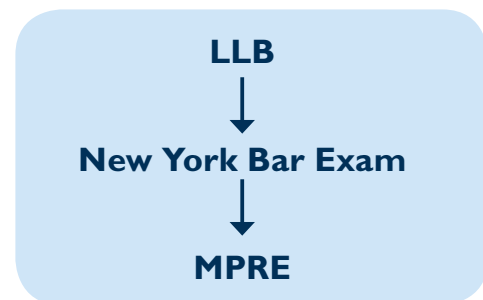
Steps to becoming a New York qualified lawyer

Step 1 - Eligibility check

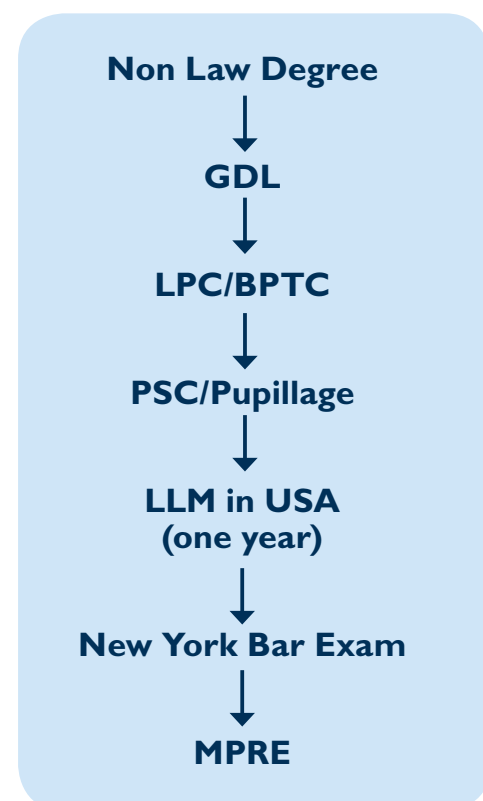
Eligibility is at the sole discretion of the New York Board of Law Examiners. They determine candidate's eligibility on a case by case basis, dependant on their academic record and experience.

Step 2 - Preparation for the New York Bar Exam

To ensure you are ready for the exam, we provide a preparation course run by Pieper. This course is tailored specifically to lawyers who have not studied law in the US. The course runs for approximately five months prior to each exam sitting - we do offer a variety of options for study including:

- Full Time - Weekdays
- Part Time - A combination of evenings and a few weekends

The course consists of approximately 175 hours of pre-recorded lectures, delivered via DVD at BPP's London, Manchester and Leeds centres. In addition to attending the DVD sessions, you will be expected to complete home study.

To ensure you have all the support you need, you will receive a pack of material designed to prepare you for success on every aspect of the New York State Bar Exam. The materials include text books featuring sample assignments and questions, past exam papers and you will also have constant access to Pieper's New York legal staff via email.

Access to BPP's Law School's library can also be provided on request.

FAQs

What does the course involve?

Approx 175 hours of lectures (via DVD).

Do the costs I pay to BPP cover my travel and accommodation when I go to New York?

How much does the preparation course cost?

£3,095 + VAT - and you will need to pay additional costs to sit the exam. The current price of the registration fee is \$250.00. This is payable to the New York Bar - usually you will need to enrol in April to sit the July exam and in November to sit the February exam. What happens if I miss a class or two?

If you miss a class, you may borrow a copy of the DVD from that class to watch in your own time, after the class has taken place. You can only borrow a maximum of seven DVDs throughout the duration of the course.

Can I just borrow the DVDs to watch on my own or is there a home study option?

No - We do not offer a home study package as by attending the courses in person with others, it will keep you on track with your revision and allow you to meet others with whom you may study.

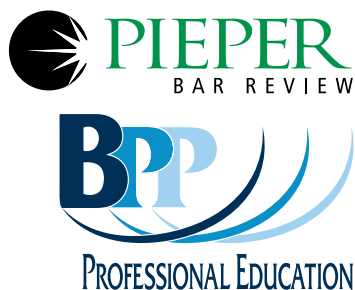
